How to Use the 5 Senses Games

The games can be used on a computer, tablet, or smartphone. They can also be shared with students via Google Classroom for distance learning!

Here's how to get it set up for your child(ren):

1. Click on the link (next page) and **MAKE A COPY** to your Google Drive. Please do not request access. You must make a copy.
2. Open the file in **YOUR** Google Drive folder.
3. If you are on a computer, click "Present" and the game will begin.
4. If you are on a phone or tablet, the game may start automatically. If it does not, click "Present" and it will start. Please note that if you do not have the free Google Drive app installed on your device, you may need to install it for the game to open and run properly.
5. Press the "START" button and then follow the directions on each slide.
6. The "Home" button will take you back to the main activity page where you can select a different activity or replay the one you just completed.

Special Steps for Using in Google Classroom:

1. After you have made a copy of the game in your Google Drive folder, you can upload it to Google Classroom to share with your students. Do **NOT** share the original link above. You must share the file from **YOUR** Google Drive folder for it to work properly.
2. When you upload it to Google Classroom, click Assign to All Students to make sure each student receives their own copy.

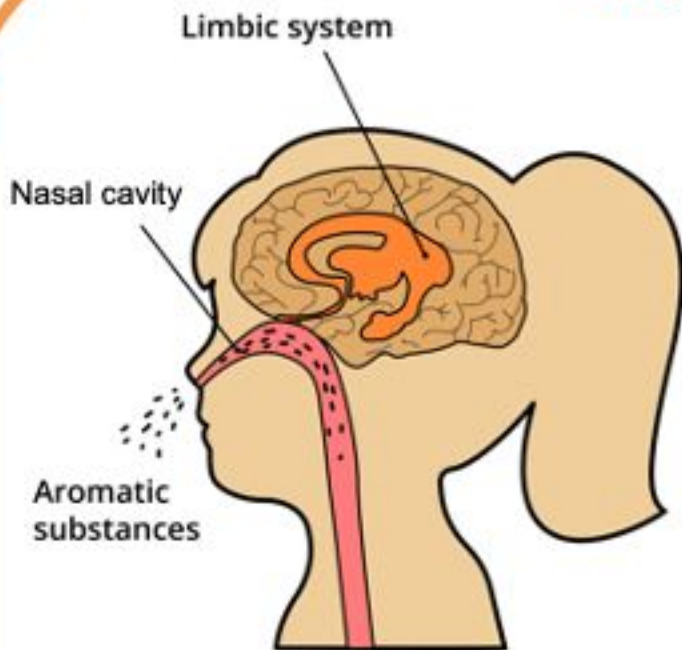


You feel things with your skin. Your skin is an organ that has many sensory receptors in it. When you touch things, the receptors send signals to your brain to help you figure out what you are feeling.

HOW TO PLAY THE GAMES

Welcome to The 5 Senses Drag & Drop Games presented by Little Bins for Little Hands!

Here's how to play the games and some helpful hints to help you navigate through the slides.

- **There are 2 different games in this file.**
 - Senses Sort is on Slide 3.
 - I Know My Senses is on Slides 4-8.
- **To Play "Senses Sort":**
 - Drag and drop the picture tiles on the left-hand side into the box for the correct sense. Some pictures may have more than one answer. Discuss with your child why they sorted the pictures the way that they did to explore their understanding of the senses.
- **To Play "I Know My Senses":**
 - Drag and drop the four picture files in the top box into the smaller boxes below based on the sense they represent. There are 4 answers for each sense.
- **Resizing Images:**
 - If your child accidentally resizes an image while moving it, hit the back arrow or click on the corner of the picture tile and resize it.
