OCEAN THEMES

Make Ocean Slime

Use the basic slime recipe with clear glue to make a beautiful glittery blue ocean slime. Add sea creatures for play!

Make Sand Slime!

Use the basic slime recipe with clear glue. Add 1/4 cup of craft or beach sand during the mix-ins step!

Make Fishbowl Slime

Use the basic slime recipe with clear glue. Add crunchy acrylifishbowl beads during the mix-ins step or after slime is made

Make Seashell Nature Slime

Use the basic slime recipe with clear glue. Add a handful of tiny shells during the mix-ins step or after the slime is made!

Make Fluffy Sand Slime

Use the fluffy sand recipe and add up to a 1/2 cup of craft or beach sand to the recipe during the mix-ins step!

Make Mermaid Slime

Use the basic slime recipe with clear glue. Make three atches each a different glittery color and swirl together.

Make Ocean Oobleck

Mix 1.5 cups of cornstarch with 1 cup of water and food coloring. Click here for full recipe.

Easy Slime Recipe for Kids

This is an awesome, versatile recipe for any of your favorite slimy themes. It also handles mix-ins very well!


For extra stretchy slime, we suggest not putting in too much saline until you have spent some time kneading your slime.

Saline Solution Slime Recipe

Mix 1/2 cup of white or clear washable school glue (Elmers is our favorite) with 1/2 cup of water.

Add a 1/4-1/2 tsp of baking soda



Stir in 1 tbsp of saline solution until slime forms. Saline solution must contain boric acid and sodium borate to work correctly.

Knead slime to desired consistency. Squirt a few drops of saline onto hands to help reduce stickiness. Sticky slime is great for mix-ins like foam beads.



For fluffy slime, omit water and replace it with 3 cups of foam shaving

For butter slime, knead in 1-2 oz of soft clay after the slime is made.

For floam slime, add in 1 cup of beads before adding saline solution. Or mix beads into already made slime!
