This super easy stethoscope really works!

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Place the small end of your funnel inside the paper towel roll.

STEP 2: Use several pieces of duct tape to attach the funnel and tube.

Duct tape
Paper towel

STEP 3: Now place the 'stethoscope' on a volunteer's chest and listen very carefully. You should be able to hear their heart beating! (Make sure the room is quiet. Try jumping around first too!)

After medical school Dr Picotte returned to the Omaha reservation to become the doctor at the government boarding school on the reservation. Her job was to teach the students about hygiene and keeping them healthy.

The local community would also come to Picotte for medical care as well. She often had 20-hour workdays and was responsible for over 1,200 people! The community trusted her, and she began making house calls and caring for patients sick with tuberculosis, influenza, cholera, dysentery, and trachoma.
