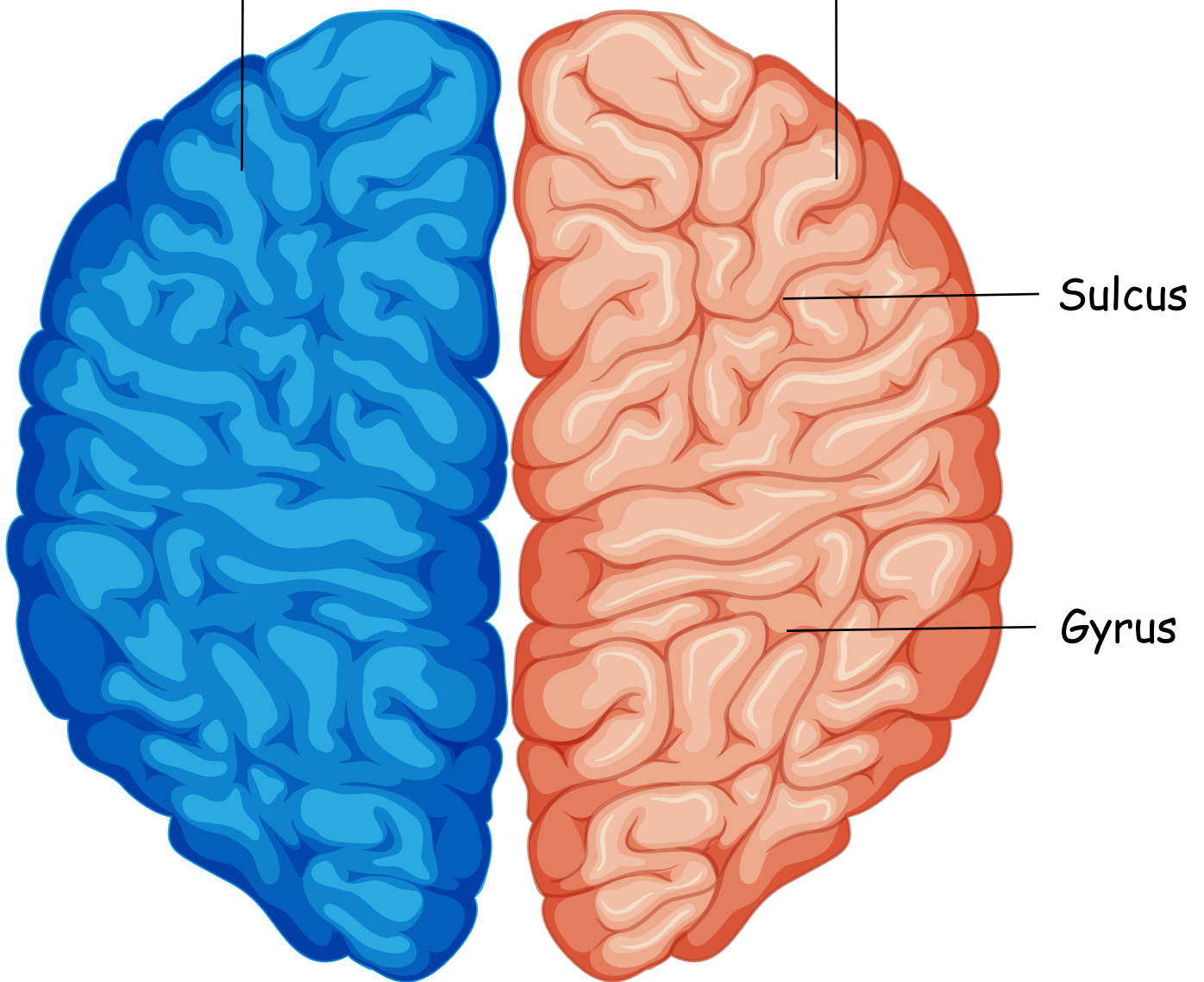


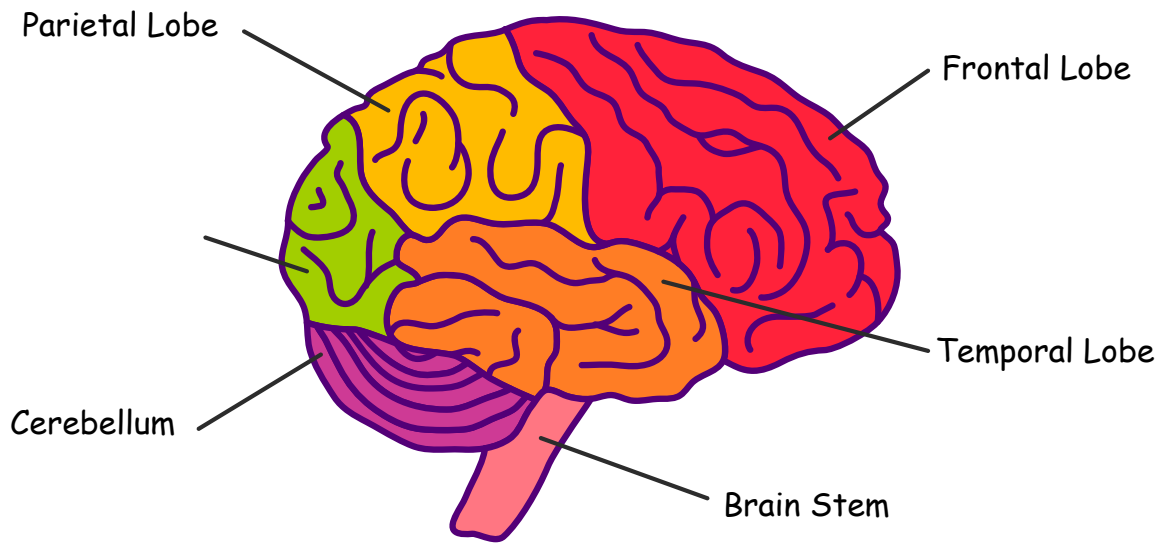
The Human Brain

Left Hemisphere

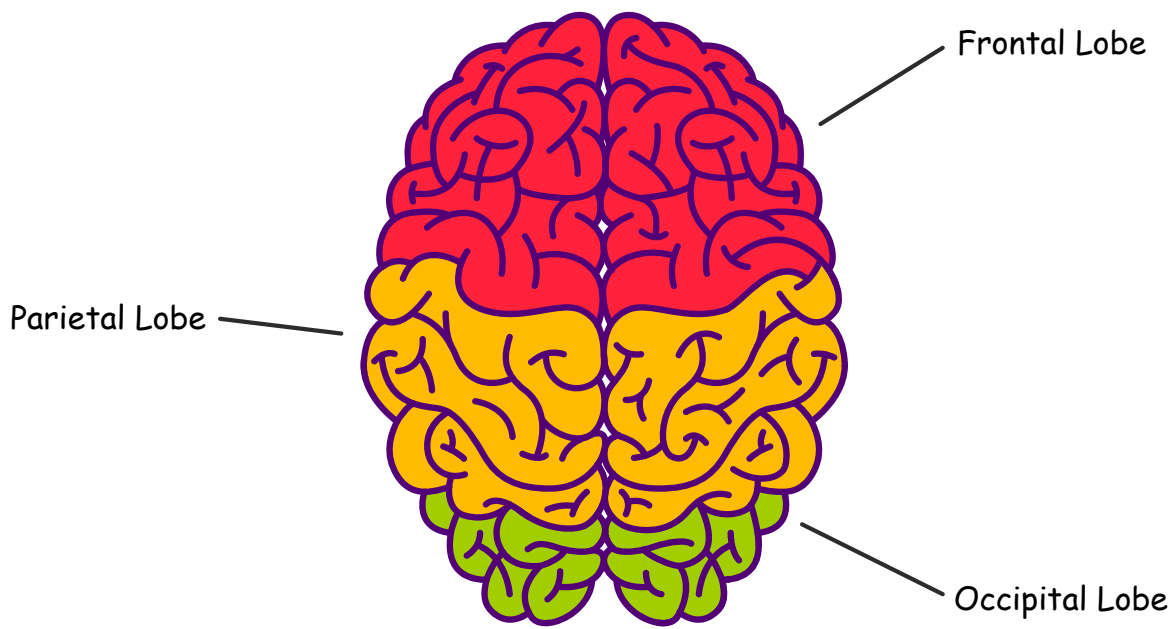
Right Hemisphere



Functional Areas of The Brain

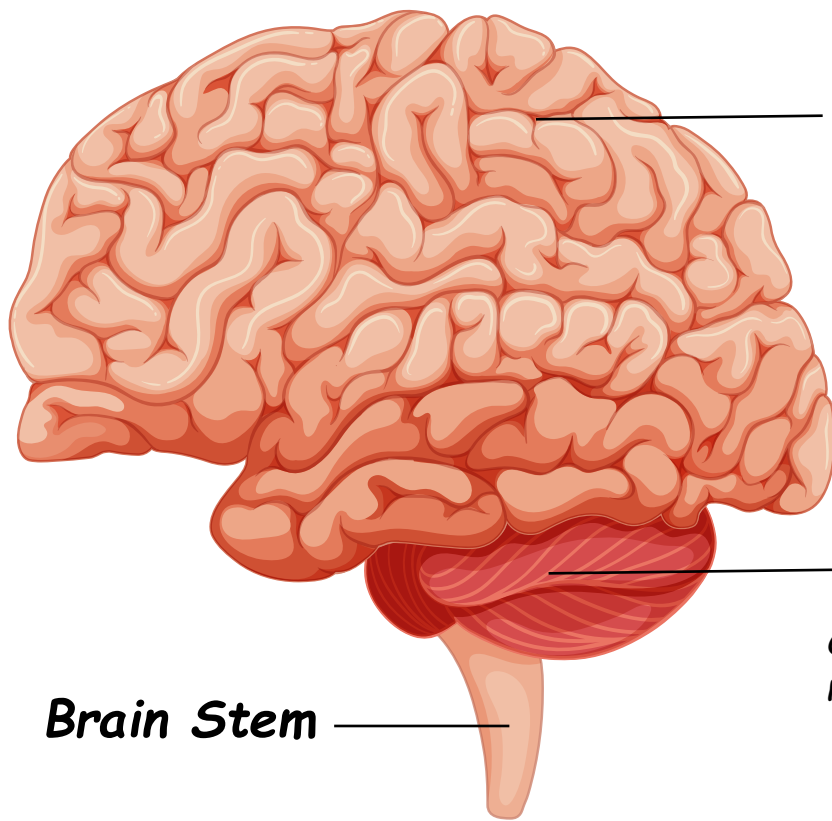


LATERAL VIEW

The 3 Main Parts of the Brain



Cerebrum

touch, vision, hearing, speech, reasoning, emotions, learning and fine control movements

Cerebellum

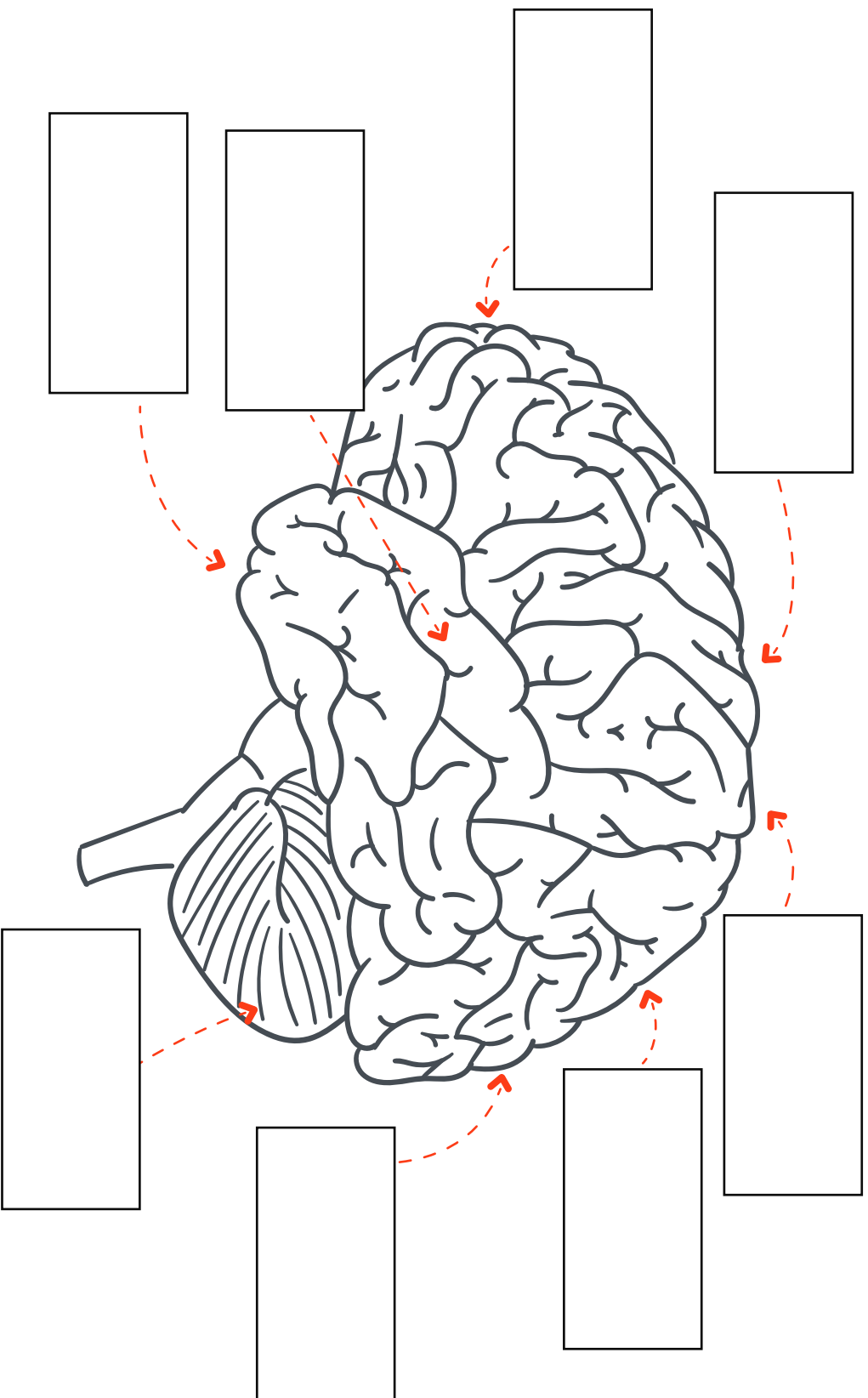
Co-ordinate muscle movements, maintain posture, and balance.

Brain Stem

relay center connecting the cerebrum and cerebellum to the spinal cord breathing, heart rate, body temperature, wake and sleep cycles, digestion, sneezing, coughing, vomiting, and swallowing.

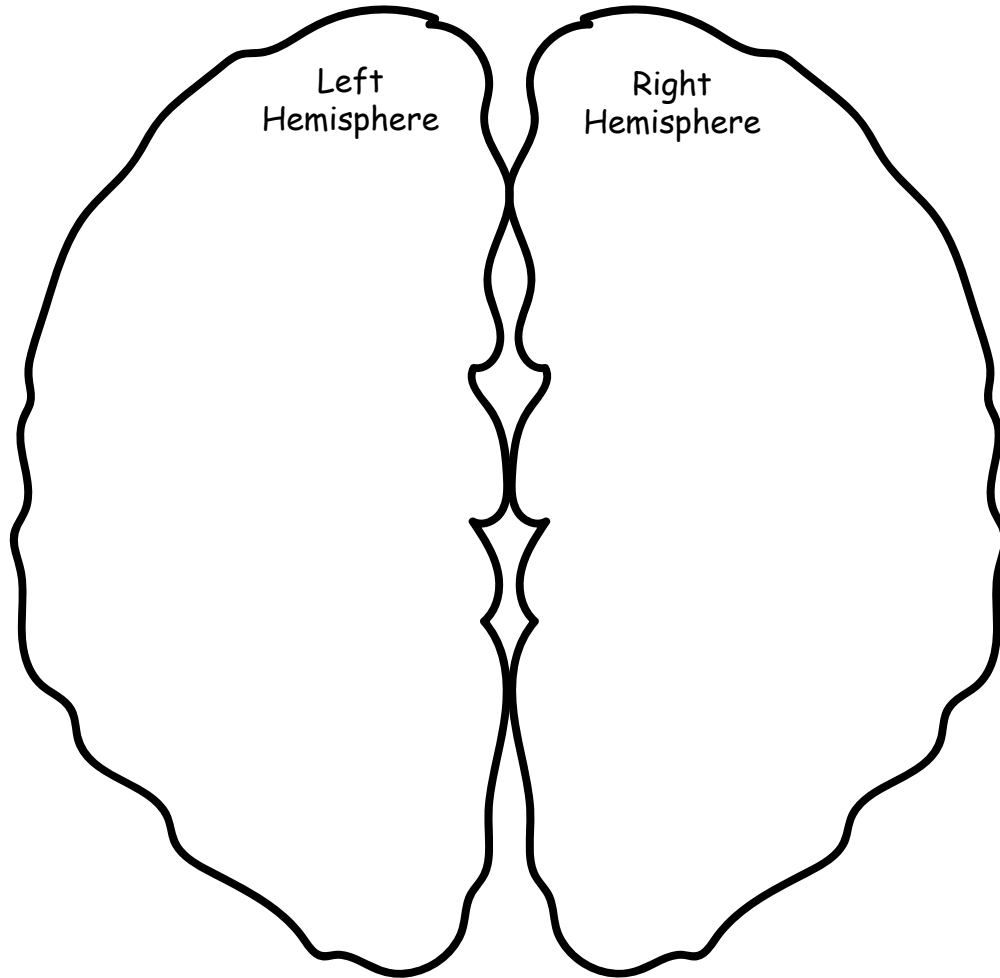

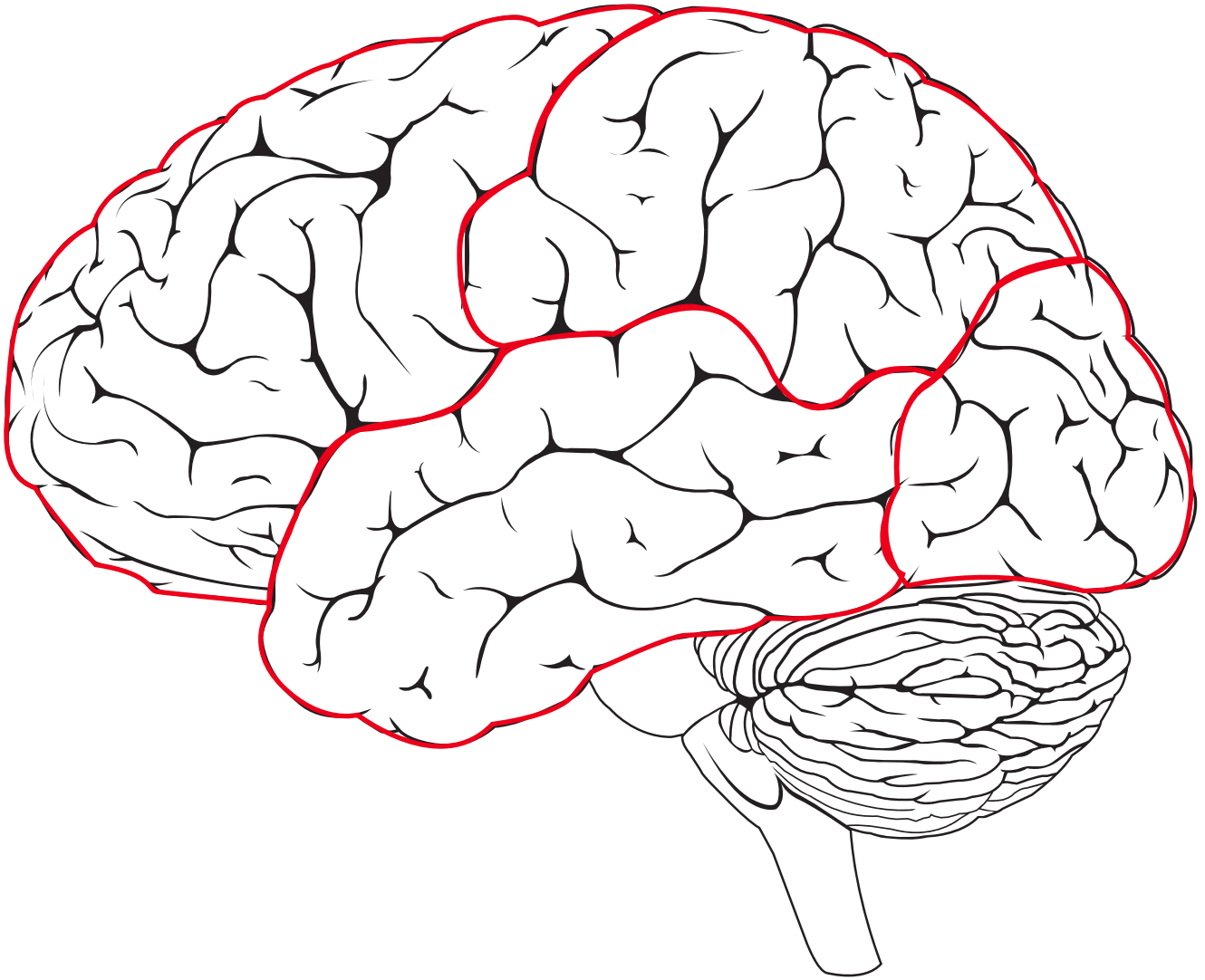
