WHO WAS MARIE THARP?

Marie Tharp was an American geologist and cartographer who created the first scientific map of the Atlantic Ocean floor. A cartographer is a person who draws or produces maps.

Her map proved the controversial theory of plate tectonics. Plate tectonics was a theory that the earth's land masses shift and move over time. But Tharp's discovery that showed that the sea floor was spreading—was initially dismissed as "girl talk."

Marie said she never would have gotten the chance to study geology if it hadn't been for Pearl Harbor. Girls were needed to fill the jobs left open because the guys were off fighting.
