## **INSTRUCTIONS**

**STEP 1:** Print the jellyfish template.

STEP 2: Mix the glue and black paint. Use to

outline your jellfish template. Let dry.

**STEP 3:** Use watercolor paints to add color to your jellyfish.

## **SUPPLIES**

Jellyfish template
Black acrylic paint
White glue
Watercolor
Salt
Scissors
Card stock

**STEP 4:** While the paint is still wet, sprinkle salt onto your design to create a textured, almost sparkly effect.

STEP 5: Once dry, cut out your jellyfish and glue to card stock.

## **JELLY FISH**

Jellyfish are fascinating creatures that live in the ocean. They belong to a group of animals called cnidarians, which also includes corals and sea anemones. Jellyfish are known for their unique appearance and graceful movements.
