ECLIPSE ART

Use colored chalk to create your own Solar Eclipse Corona!

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Use the pencil to trace around your bowl onto the card stock paper.

STEP 2: Cut out the card stock circle.

STEP 3: Place the circle onto your black paper.

STEP 4: Using colored chalk, hold the circle in place and draw around it making quick, tiny marks. Use various colors, including a good amount of white.

STEP 5: When you are done with the marks, remove the circle and carefully use your finger to smudge the chalk along the inside of the circle. This will create a look similar to the sun during a total solar eclipse.

SOLAR ECLIPSE

A total solar eclipse is like a magical show in the sky. Imagine the Sun as a big, bright light, and the Moon comes in between the Sun and the Earth, making the light disappear for a little while. It gets dark, and the sky looks different, almost like nighttime during the day. This special moment is called a total solar eclipse. In some places, people can see the Sun's outer glow, called the solar corona, creating a beautiful ring of light.
