
# JANE GOODALL

Jane Goodall is a British primatologist and anthropologist. Considered to be the world's foremost expert on chimpanzees, Goodall is best known for her over 55-year study of social and family interactions of wild chimpanzees.

Goodall is best known for her study of chimpanzee social and family life. She began studying the Kasakela chimpanzee community in Tanzania in 1960.

Instead of numbering the chimpanzees she observed, she gave them names such as Fifi and David Greybeard, and observed them to have unique and individual personalities, an unconventional idea at the time. She found that, "It isn't only human beings who have personality, who are capable of rational thought [and] emotions like joy and sorrow". She also observed behaviors such as hugs, kisses, pats on the back, and even tickling, what we consider 'human' actions.


Goodall established the Jane Goodall Institute (JGI), which supports the Gombe research, and she is a global leader in the effort to protect chimpanzees and their habitats.



As a child, as an alternative to a teddy bear her father gave Goodall a stuffed chimpanzee named Jubilee, and she has said her fondness for this figure started her early love of animals.


Jane Goodall is a world-renowned primatologist, anthropologist, and environmentalist who is widely recognized for her groundbreaking work with chimpanzees.

**STEP 1:** Print our chimpanzee face.


**STEP 2:** Color the face.
